

This is the Wilderness Lectures Covid Pandemic commitment for 2022 and 2023, dated July 2022

Although UK Government policy is "living with Covid" it is very clear that new, highly virulent forms continue to arise with the possibility that new public health restrictions are possible, especially through the coming winter months.

Our commitment to the Wilderness Lectures audience is:

We will follow Government guidance/regulation regarding public indoor events.

If the lectures can't be held because guidance changes or the speaker or organisers contract Covid, we will seek to reschedule the lecture at a later date and the tickets will remain valid. Alternatively, we will offer a refund.

If the lectures go ahead on the date advertised, but you consider yourself particularly vulnerable and would prefer to avoid sitting in an indoor lecture, pre-purchased tickets can be returned for a refund providing they are received by us on the morning of the lecture or we are notified by email prior to the day of the lecture that they have been posted.

Our commitment to our speakers is:

We will seek to ensure the lectures go ahead unless Government guidance/regulation prevents it. If this arises, we will seek to reschedule the lecture in liaison with the speaker.

We ask our speakers to work with the Wilderness Team and provide as much advance notice as possible if they have to withdraw due to Covid, in order for us to notify our audience.
